

ONE DAY SEMINAR ON CHILDLINE 1098

A one day seminar was held in Nagaland University, Kohima Campus on “Creating Awareness about CHILDLINE 1098” on the 10th of November 2017. The program was organised by the Women’s Studies Centre, Nagaland University. The Key note address was delivered by the Director of Women’s Studies Centre Prof. Buno Zetsuvi who also chaired the seminar. In the Seminar Prof. R.C. Gupta, the Pro Vice Chancellor of Nagaland University, Kohima Campus spoke on the global and national scenario of children. He stressed on the importance of nurturing the young minds by creating and leaving positive impressions in them.
